

WEST DISTRICT MISSIONAL EXCELLENCE
Funding Application

- District Missions Grants may be requested to support new or expanding ministries of the church, and to assist congregations with mission trips or projects. Grants normally do not exceed \$3000, and may be of a lesser amount.
- Grants in consecutive years will be allowed with priority going to churches that have not received one in the prior twelve months. The district will also not fund the same mission cause (i.e. a repeated project or trip) in a congregation even if there has been no grant conveyed in two or more years.
- *Grants from the current year district budget will not be made for improvements or repairs in local churches.*
- The application for district mission funds must be made in advance of the project proposed. The district will seldom consider funding projects retroactively.
- **Spring/summer grant application deadline: April 30. Fall/Winter application deadline: August 30.**
