

PURPOSE OF LAY SERVANT SCHOOL

To become better equipped to serve Jesus Christ, His church, and community; to grow spiritually; and to become a Local Church Lay Servant or a Certified UM Lay Servant.

Local Church Lay Servant

LCLS serve in their local churches. To become a LCLS you must be recommended by your pastor, Charge Conference, District Lay Servant Committee and the D.S. You must complete the Basic Course for Lay Servants, and apply each year by reporting on ways you have served and continued your spiritual journey during the year.

Certified Lay Servant

A CLS may serve In District and Conference settings beyond the local congregation; however, you must continue to serve in your local congregation. A CLS must be recommended by his/her pastor and Charge Conference; must have completed the Basic course and one Advanced course; be approved by the Lay Servant Ministry Committee and the D.S.; must report and reapply annually. To stay certified as a CLS, you must complete an Advanced Course once every three years.

All courses require:

- Attendance for the entire 10 hours
- Fulfilling course requirements
- Presenting a 5-7-minute talk
